AGRICULTURAL VALUES Chris Barzilla gave an overview on the different categories and commented that the district did not receive a lot of lease information for the year. Mr. David Groschke questioned the increase in the category of row crops. Chris Barzilla stated that the leases received were for watermelons and that those leases paid more per acre. Chris Barzilla also mentioned that the majority of the ag values did not change and that the district uses the states timber values.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the 2017 ag values as presented to the board, with the exception of row crops and that the price per acre will be corrected to \$300/acre.
